

Bridge-for-Europe Nationality Civil Conciliation Forum

The HÍD – ENCEF association was formed with a 3-person chairmanship and 20 members in April 2005. The purpose of the association is to unite the national civil organisations, communities and private persons, to represent their interest and to promote the BRIDGE role during the establishment of international relations.

In order to achieve the goals of the association the most important tasks are the following:

- Supply the members of the association with news, information and announcements for competitions.
- Organise conferences, meetings, international programmes to strengthen the co-operation and the role of non-profit organisations to the benefit of a firm democratic society.
- Organise actions between business, civil and government organisations (at local, county, regional, national and EU level).
- Represent of the national civil (community) interests at decisions by EU, or state and local authorities, follow up and form opinion on the work of forums in this issue.
- Participate with the interests of the nationalities in the shaping and strengthening of the Regions of Europe, promote national, minority and European identity.
- The organisation would like to support the preparation of civil organisations of neighbouring countries for the European regionalism.

Our long-term plan is to expand the network of ENCEF in other countries, and facilitate the effective flow of information, just as well interests mediation inside and outside the EU.

Within the framework of an international conference, at first we intend to learn more about the work of minority organisations in the given countries and get to know the possible problems. We would like to compile a report on the basis of the gathered information and present it to the competent national and EU organisations.
